



How to get here

By Air

Our nearest and most consistent all year round airport is Toulouse which is a 1h30 drive from us. This services most major UK and European airports, and has a complete range of car hire companies. There is also a half hourly shuttle which will take you to Toulouse Matabiau main station. Guests joining the group later in the week may choose to take a train rather than hire a second car.

By Train

Najac station is 15 minutes from us. Najac is on a small line between Toulouse and Figeac/Aurillac with regular trains throughout the day. Details on this service can be found on the local train website <https://www.ter.sncf.com/midi-pyrenees>

Tip: On the timetable, the trains marked Tikemouv on the 3rd line down are eligible for Tikemouv tickets (7.50€ instead of 18€), but you must ask for the Tikemouv ticket at the ticket office on the day of travel.

By Car

From Toulouse Airport

Exit the airport complex following the sign to Toulouse.

Join the dual carriageway, and keep right. You will soon see signs for Paris/Bordeaux/Albi, follow these signs, you are looking to eventually get to the A68 towards Albi, so follow the signs to Albi by Autoroute. *At one point there is a sign to Albi par RD (green sign) which is the old road - do not take this, stay on the ring road, and you will see a sign to Albi by autoroute (blue sign) almost immediately after).*

You will then go through a Toll, which will cost 1€50, which can be paid by cash or card.

Follow A68 for 50km, and take Exit 9 towards Gaillac.

You should now start following signs to Cordes-sur-Ciel. This will take you all round the edge of Gaillac before you turn left and climb into the vineyard covered hills.

TIP: 1 km after the motorway exit, on the right there is a huge Leclerc supermarket. Probably the biggest you are likely to see during your stay.


When you arrive in Cordes-sur-Ciel, turn right on to the D922, signposted Laguepie.

In Laguepie, cross the river and follow the D922 towards Villefranche.

After 10km (10 mins), you will arrive at St Andre de Najac.

After 1km turn right on D544 signposted Bor et Bar, follow this road and turn left at T junction.

Gite des Milans is part of La Lande and is 450m on the left behind grey iron gates



From the North

You will most likely be travelling South on the A20.

Take Exit 56 towards Figeac. (La Lande is approximately 1h30 from here)

As you approach Figeac, you will see signs to Villefranche. Follow these, and this will bypass Figeac.

Follow D922 to Villefranche.

TIP: Villefranche de Rouergue is the main market town for the area, and has the major hypermarkets, Carrefour and Leclerc. Both are signposted at the entry to the town.


Go round the town one-way system, and cross the river then shortly after turn right towards Najac/La Fouillade.

After 15km, you will arrive at La Fouillade with an Intermarche on your right and a Pharmacie on your left. 150m further on turn left on to the D39 into the village of La Fouillade.

Go through the village, past the Mairie, the bars and the boulanger.

After 1km, turn right down the D69 towards Bor et Bar.

Stay on this road for 3km, and La Lande is on your right behind grey iron gates (Gite des Milans is part of La Lande).
